



Level 2 Club Coach (WAG, MAG, or GG)

We are **Maldon Gymnastics Club** (previously **Blackwater Gymnastics Club**). We currently operate from a specially adapted Scout Hut in Tolleshunt D'Arcy and are in the process of relocating to a 5,000 sq ft facility in Maldon — an exciting and significant step for us. We anticipate being ready to operate in the new location from **February**.

We are a fast-growing 4 year old club with a friendly, passionate, and supportive coaching team. This is the perfect time to join us, as there are a number of positive developments underway.

We offer a mix of 1-hour and 2-hour recreational sessions, squad and mini-squad training, and we compete in NGA competitions. In the **2025 NGA season**, 10 out of 11 of our gymnasts qualified for National Finals — an exceptional achievement for a small club competing against long-established larger clubs. Many of our gymnasts returned home with all-around trophies and apparatus medals, highlighting the excellent coaching behind our young and growing club.

We also deliver one SEN session and one Home Ed session each week. We intend to continue offering birthday parties at weekends, and aim to create a dedicated “party team” working on a rota.

You will be allocated new recreational groups across a range of ages. In time you will be able to select a new development group you can grow alongside other recreational session.

Some school holiday work will be required.

As a Level 2 coach, you may also run private 1:1 sessions.

If you have taken a break from coaching, training / refresh support is available.
