The Role

We are seeking a **Level 3 or 4 Women's Artistic Gymnastics (WAG) coach** with several years' experience in developing squad gymnasts.

You will work alongside our squad coaching team, supporting gymnasts preparing for NGA UK competitions. Depending on your working hours, initially you may also deliver recreational sessions across a range of ages, including potential morning hours.

As the role develops, you will have the opportunity to **select and grow your own development group**.

Some work during school holidays will be required, including open sessions, workshops, and camps.

Level 2+ coaches may also deliver private 1:1 sessions.
